FURNITURE COVER INSTALLATION

BEFORE COVERING

Before covering your furniture, clean all surfaces and allow furniture to dry completely. Failure to do so can result in mildew which is not covered under warranty. Cleaning instructions for furniture may be found on Kingsley Bate's website at: http://kingsleybate.com/faq-care.php

INSTALLING YOUR COVERS

The proper method for fitting covers will depend on your type of furniture.

Dining Sets, Tables, Cushion Boxes

- 1. Prepare your furniture to be covered:
 - Dining sets and tables: remove and store your umbrella, if applicable.
 - Square and rectangular dining sets: there must be chairs on all sides of the table for the cover to fit properly (Figure A). Chairs should be centered left to right and should not be pushed under table.
 - Round dining sets: chairs should be distributed evenly around the table and pushed under the table prior to covering.
- 2. Unbuckle the adjustable straps on your cover.
- 3. Place the cover over the furniture.
- 4. If the cover includes a tenting device, reach under the cover and stand the tent vertically on the top surface (Figure B). If there is one tent it should be placed in the center of the top; if there are two, space them evenly along the top. Proper placement of tents is important for water drainage and ventilation.
- 5. For dining sets, adjust chairs until the seam along the top edge of the cover is resting on the top of the chair backs (Figure C).
- 6. See "After Covering" below.

Seating, Chaise

- 1. Prepare your furniture to be covered:
 - Sectionals: unclip units, if applicable, and separate them slightly to allow space for the cover.
 - Furniture with back cushions: lay back cushion(s) down flat on the seat cushion(s).
 - Chaises: the back must be in the flat position.
- 2. Unbuckle the adjustable straps on your cover. For seating, the side of the cover that has the *long* straps attached will go on the *backside* of the furniture.
- 3. Place the cover over the furniture.

AFTER COVERING

- 1. Pass the straps underneath the furniture and buckle. We recommend that two people perform this procedure.
- 2. The straps are adjustable, and it may be necessary to tighten or loosen them for a proper fit. Be careful not to over tighten, as doing so can reduce ventilation.
